

Fair Access to the Squash Courts

Squash and the PSC have become very popular lately. From September through May, our courts are very well used. In August 2016, with input from the members, the PSC Board acted to allow all members fair access to the courts by including Rule 5c as part of the overall updating of the House Rules. This Rule states that a member cannot reserve overlapping or consecutive court reservation slots. Copies of the updated House Rules were sent to all members and posted on the Club bulletin boards and web site. At present, the Board is only implementing Rule 5c during the prime-time hours (denoted as PT on the reservation sign-up pages).

The Board asks that all members abide by Rule 5c, allowing your fellow members to have fair access to the courts during these popular hours. The Board also asks that a pair of members not "game" the reservation system by each member reserving one of the two overlapping or consecutive courts. However, if a court is unreserved during a prime time slot, members are welcome to play on the unused court, provided these members have not made the court unavailable to other members in violation of Rule 5c.

The PSC is a member-owned club, and it is expected that each member respects the rules and the other members without the enforcement by the Board. The Board reminds all members that court time, especially during prime time, is the PSC's scarcest resource. We ask all members to help protect it.
